PERKINS V: The Association for Career & Technical Education (ACTE) posted the following notice on October 19th: Recently, a group of senators sent a letter to the leaders of the Senate Health, Education, Labor and Pensions (HELP) Committee in support of Perkins reauthorization. The House of Representatives [unanimously passed](#) the Strengthening Career and Technical Education for the 21st Century Act, which would reauthorize the Perkins Act, in June. However, the Senate has yet to act on a Perkins bill that would make important improvements to the federal system of support for CTE. The letter, sponsored by Senators Jim Inhofe (R-OK) and Claire McCaskill (D-MO), encouraged the HELP committee to [take up Perkins reauthorization](#) without delay. Follow Perkins reauthorization news on the [CTE Policy Watch Blog](#). The CTE Policy watch blog has shown no changes a month out from this post. At CCCAOE a representative from Brustein & Manasevit stated they did not believe that Perkins V would be authorized this year.

Deputy Sector Matching Funds Available

The CCCCCO Workforce and Economic Development Division is making match funds available to encourage in vetting Strong Workforce dollars in projects that adopt or adopt/adapt Industry Sector Projects-in-Common (ISPIC). ISPIC projects make it easier for colleges (or regional consortia of colleges) to deliver ‘more and better career education’ in areas of labor market demand. Each Sector Navigator will have up to \$400,000 in matching funds to deploy and drive workforce outcomes found in LaunchBoard. In order to access the match Districts will review the ISPIC Index for curated opportunities they may wish to explore in order to drive student outcomes listed in LaunchBoard. The ISPIC Index projects have been identified by Sector Navigators (SN) and Deputy Sector Navigators (DSN). Next, reach out to the pertinent Sector Navigator to express interest in adopting or adopting/adapting projects, to better understand how the process will roll out, and to know how commitments of matches can be obtained.

CIO CSSO First Friday Update

The First Friday Update:

- AB 705’s primary tenets to utilize high school grades as a key placement indicator and maximize curriculum opportunities to move students through math and English to reach transfer level in one year;
- Assembly Bill 637 (Medina) was approved by Governor Brown (Chapter 743, Statutes of 2017). Associated updates to distance education regulations will take place in early 2018. Subsequent guidelines for intra-district online cross enrollment in the Online Education Initiative Course Exchange are under development.
- Associate Degrees for Transfer -- Currently, the total number of active Associate Degrees for Transfer (ADTs) is 2,296.
