Perkins/CTE Federal Issues

Perkins V

Since the House of Representatives voted to pass a [bipartisan, comprehensive Perkins Act reauthorization bill](#) in both 2016 and 2017, all eyes have been on the Senate HELP Committee to follow suit. The Perkins Act, which has not been reauthorized since 2006, as a result, workforce development stakeholders, including employers, educators and policymakers, have remained steadfast in calling for action on the Perkins Act since it became eligible for reauthorization in 2010. This week, the Senate HELP Committee provided notice that they plan to consider a Perkins Act reauthorization bill on Wednesday, June 20th. In light of this recent development, National Skills Coalition [submitted a set of recommendations](#) to Chairman Lamar Alexander (R-SC) and Ranking Member Murray (D-WA), proposing ways to make the Act work better for students and employers in today's economy. These recommendations urged the Committee to:

The two current issues between the House and Senate are that the Senate Republicans want language that would limit the ability of USDE to regulate on Perkins and Senate Republicans want more flexibility in using Perkins allocations for things like student vouchers (which is very strongly opposed by CTE groups).

Perkins IV Title I-B Leadership Payments 2017-18

Almost 100% of invoices have now been processed for the first three quarters of Leadership funding. For 2018-19 Rancho Santiago will be the fiscal agent for the Regional Consortia Leadership allocation [June 4th memo from Dean Matt Roberts](#). The Chancellor's Office will still be responsible for program (approving applications and monitoring the grants).

Perkins IV Allocations 2018-19

Expect final allocations for Perkins in October. At that time the Chancellor's Office will give instructions for amending amounts.

Quarterly Reporting – Every quarter districts are required to report and certify their Perkins [Title I-C](#), [CTE Transitions](#), and [Title I-B](#) expenditures in the Year-To-Date Expenditures and Progress Report online system.
