Perkins/CTE Federal Issues

Perkins V

Most recent news from Michael Brustein is that the House and Senate are now at odds with the authority of the Secretary of State and the funding formula (complicating the Perkins V debate). Therefore it looks like reauthorization of Perkins V will not be passed by January 2019.

Perkins IV Title I-B Leadership Payments 2017-18

Title I-B Perkins Leadership will be invoiced as one progress payment (all three quarters in one) and are currently being processed by the lead of Chancellor's Office Title I-B.

Perkins IV Allocations 2018-19

The 2018-19 Perkins Title I, Part C and CTE Transitions combined online application is now available for data entry (using preliminary figures) as of Monday, May 14, 2018 and certification by the District will be required by Monday June 4, 2018. If the federal budget issues are resolved before the June 4, 2018 certification date, the Chancellors Office will release the final allocations, and the Districts will make budget adjustment from the current application. Otherwise, an amendment to applications will happen later and instructions sent to all Districts at that time.

Regional Consortia (Perkins Leadership)

The Board of Governors (in its May meeting held this week) approved an extension for Regional Consortia grants. Therefore for fiscal year 2018-19 Regional Consortia will be extended under the original 2013-14 RFA and will be sent a renewal memo with instructions, a facesheet and the appropriate forms in May with a fast turnaround in order to substantially approve those grants before June 30, 2018.

Quarterly Reporting – Every quarter districts are required to report and certify their Perkins [Title I-C](#), [CTE Transitions](#), and [Title I-B](#) expenditures in the Year-To-Date Expenditures and Progress Report online system. The reporting schedule ensures that districts are reimbursed in a timely manner. The following reporting dates will apply for FY 2017-18.

[Centers of Excellence Memo April 27th](#) -- The Chancellor's Office is providing a 4-month extension starting July 1, 2018 through October 31, 2018. This augmentation will be processed through a Fiscal agent.

1. For the current COE grant in FY 17-18 ending on June 30, 2018 all expenditures must be reported in the online system in order to complete the final report, which must be submitted 30 days after the term end date.
2. July 1, 2018 – October 31, 2018 (a four-month extension) in the amount of \$70,000 will be processed through the Fiscal Agent. All expenditures must be reported in the online system in order to complete the final report, which must be submitted 30 days after the new end date of October 31, 2018.

Notification of RFAs from Workforce Economic Development Division

Data Research and Analytics Project (\$3.5 Million) RFA -- Deadline May 25th

[Data Research and Analytics Project](#). -- This Request for Application (RFA) aims to build a central location for big data research, big data products, analytics, statistical modeling, machine learning and real-time personalization services. By analyzing all the data aggregated by the Chancellor’s Office into CCC Data Lake, we will create a robust Business Intelligence environment, providing timely, accurate, and understandable reports to CCC decision-makers.

Shared Infrastructure Program (\$18.4 Million) RFA -- Deadline May 25th

[Shared Infrastructure Program](#) (SIP) seeks to provide common technology products and services that support the larger CCC community. The SIP leverages the strategic technology plans and recommendations that are developed by the Telecommunications and Technology Advisory Committee (TTAC) to obtain input from the CCC community.

Application Student Personalization Services Fiscal Agent Grant (\$2.0 Million) RFA -- Deadline May 25th

[Application Student Personalization Services](#) (ASPS) Fiscal Agent Grant will closely partner and collaborate successfully with Data Services, Data Research and Analytics, and all application providers to build a universal look and feel for the applications used in the California Community College environment. The grantee will be tasked with leveraging UI/UX principles, application integration, behavioral sciences, accessibility regulations, security standards, mass personalization, scalable application design, and agile application development to support the objectives of this grant.

California Community Colleges Core Applications Project (\$9.5 Million) RFA -- Deadline June 29th

The [California Community Colleges Core Applications Project](#) (CCCCAP) Grant aims to look at the tools developed over the last 8 years that support students course of study and education plans and create an environment where these software work in a coordinated manner. In coordination with the Chancellor's Office, the grantee will be tasked with analyzing the need for software applications and services to support the mission of the CCC and identify gaps in services, alignment, user interface integration, authentication consistency, data flow, and other application aspects to ensure creation of applications and software services that provide students and CCC employees with seamless experiences.

Data Services Program Grant (4.7 Million RFA) -- Deadline June 29th

[Data Services Program](#) Request For Application (RFA) works to solve the problem of separate and disparate, decentralized data by implementing changes across the California Community Colleges (CCC) environment. The grantee will be tasked with establishing a Data Lake to aggregate all CCC data and secure it according to the Chancellor's Office's cyber-security standards and policies. The creation of a centralized Data Lake will ensure continuous, accurate, and timely data and facilitate successful collaboration across various all RFA services teams. In coordination with the Data Research and Analytics Project will provide a real-time data access infrastructure that provides for data reporting, dash boarding and presentation as well as a central repository for current and future MOU documents and agreements to support data projects.
