1st Regional Program Endorsement: BIW Program

Mobilizing as a region, LAOCRC responded to the high employment growth and stable livable wages found in the Business Information Worker (BIW) pathway program by approving the first regional endorsement of a program!

By design, this pre-approval endorses any LA/OC college to develop a new BIW program, or substantially change an existing program to align with the statewide Information Communication Technology/ Digital Media (ICT/DM) sector BIW program.

With a five-year projection to add 20,515 jobs in the region, a 13.6% increase, this approval expedites the local process allowing the colleges to quickly respond to industry and better serve the needs of students. In just 8 courses with the BIW pathway, students will gain marketable skills in digital and web literacy to get hired or advance within a broad range of office environments.

This regional project will serve as a model that can be adopted and modified for future pathway programs.

Michael Brustein will conduct a comprehensive training on new federal requirements recently adopted by the U.S. Education Department (ED) and codified in the new EDGAR (to be released in December 2015). Important changes have now been made to regulations covering equipment, supplies, indirect costs, time and effort certifications, procurement, travel, conflicts, conference/meal costs, risk-based monitoring



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and audits. ED has released significant policy change in the past few months. Perkins IV monitoring and audit findings (supplanting, CTSO transportation costs, accountability, size, scope, quality of projects, programs of study), funding, Perkins V Reauthorization, and the impact of AEFLA/WIOA changes on Perkins which go into effect on 7/1/2016 will be discussed.
